

Retreatants were getting used to receiving morning Darshans from their Beloved Heart Master when He returned from Lion's Lap where He had been spending nights. He would arrive by sport utility vehicle or boat and if it Pleased Him He would Offer the most sweetly intimate Darshans from either the outer court-yard or the veranda outside His bedroom. We were so fortunate; it Pleased Him to grant these Darshans almost every day.

But there would be no such occasion on a morning shortly after the Celebration of Guru Purnima. I was only momentarily disappointed, however. We were told to gather in the open air Darshan Hall of Samraj Mahal overlooking the beach where Beloved Adi Da was about to land. The view from the arched windows could not have been better. We stood with our hands raised in the Gesture of Beholding, as the boat rapidly approached the shore. Just before it would have grounded Adi Da swung the boat sharply to the left where it was caught and held firm by two waiting attendants.

We saw close up what we had only seen from a distance before, the loving choreography of the helping our Beloved Guru out of His windbreaker and cap, giving Him His Staff, Adi Dasya Sukapurani assisting Him as he stepped from the boat and into the water, cleaning His Sacred Feet so that He could slip on His beach shoes, being given the leash to His canine devotee, Toto, the efficient unloading of supplies, the assembly of devotees behind their

master as He now walked away from Samraj Mahal in His unhurried and economical way that covers a lot of ground and carries Him out of sight before you know it. It was a simple, moving, beautiful tableau of our Master and His devotees. And we in Samraj Mahal had participated in some version of it everyday since we arrived.



So what accounts for the fact that my heart went wild as we watched? WILD!. My so solid-minded strategy was not merely cracked wide open, it was simply vanished. I suddenly loved my Guru as I never had before. It was a love unlike anything I had known for my intimate partner, my parents, sister, grandchildren or best friends. It was completely clear to me that this was Guru love and it was rapturous.
